These regulations may be altered, deleted or modified at the annual General Body meetings or by a Special General Body meeting convened for this purpose when a resolution to the effect is passed by two thirds of the members present and voting.

21) DISSOLUTION/ OR AMALGATION WITH ANOTHER BODY/ SOCIETY/ASSOCIATION TRUST

(a) If at any time it should appear to the Executive Committee that it is necessary or desirable that the affairs of the Association should be dissolved an Extra-ordinary General Body meeting shall be convened to consider the matter.

(b) Any resolution under this regulation must be passed a majority of not less than three-fourth of the members of the Association.

(c) Upon dissolution of the Association, the remaining assets after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities and property shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the Association or any of them, but shall be given to a similar registered society or the government, to be determined by votes of not less than two thirds of the members present personally at the time of dissolution, or in default by any court of judicature.

22) INTERPRETATION

In case of any doubt regarding the interpretation of any provision of these byes - laws / regulations, the decision of the President shall be final.

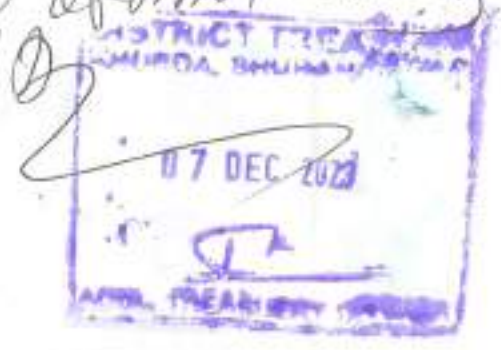
